The MAXSON Tag Inserter represents the latest design of counting and marking systems – a principle first patented in 1926 by Charles B. Maxson, the Company's founder. The Tag Inserter can be impulse from an existing or new counter and, in the case of multiple rolls, a counter with a multiplier. It possesses the following benefits:

- Positive, dependable pneumatic actuation of the tag feed out and tag cut off.
- Rugged design for long service and low maintenance.
- Can operate with $\pm 1/32$ " variation in $3/4$ " tag stock without difficulty.
- Standard units are assembled and pretested for quick delivery, with snout adaptors available for special applications.
